
A Wedding For All Seasons

At Glenlo Abbey Hotel & Estate, our weddings are inspired by mother nature and the changing seasons.


Each season infuses your wedding with its own unique blend of colours, textures and moods.


Revel in the cool summer vibe, the infectious laughter of your guests and the excitement that fills the air.

Outdoors, the romantic winter landscape, the serenity of Lough Corrib, the frost on the pine trees, the crisp chill of the air.


Cosying up indoors, to the flicker of candlelight, the blaze of log fires and the heightened sense of belonging, of togetherness with your loved ones.
